

Proposed gallery with faceted glass balustrade with curved timber rail and manifestations at lower level for privacy.

New Kitchen located at west end of south aisle - with 2 no. servery hatches (1 no. east & 1 no. north - with folding shutters) located within the timber panelled enclosures.

Concealed door to storage cupboard to house trolley providing storage for up to 6 round tables.

Ground floor to nave, aisles and tower raised to match level of Chancel floor. Floor finish to be Purbeck Limestone

Memorials/plaques to be relocated from area of wall below.

Partition wall to enclose spaces below new gallery, to be clad in vertical oak board, extending up over base of glass balustrade above.

Folding centre-pivot timber-framed glazed door screen to allow nave to be opened up to multi functional spaces beyond.

New glazed screen (inc. double-swing doors) set within the Tower arch with manifestation applied.

Oak storage cupboards positioned on splay of tower walls at first floor level.

Oak cupboards to enclose Aspiration Unit (refer to EEP details) mounted on wall, with low level oak storage unit below

Existing historic north door adjusted and retained (to be kept open when building is in use)

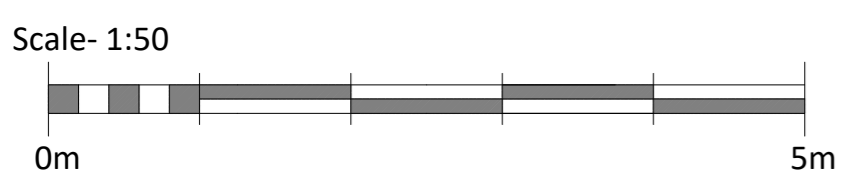
New inner glazed door

RevA - Existing timber gates to be retained, restored and relocated inside the arch behind the swing of the new doors

New traditional solid timber boarded doors to be made and fitted within outer opening - to be held open when church is in use

Service cupboard to enclose under floor heating manifold, with vertical timber cladding to match partition wall behind.

Existing floor to north porch, adjusted and re-laid to provide ramped access from external access through to inner door (Principal entrance)
