Prayer Pointers

(please take this bulletin home with you to pray)

- Pray for those in this Deanery who will come for Confirmation this week, that they may be assured of God's love and the guidance of the Holy Spirit to give them wisdom and understanding and renewed hope as they face the challenges of daily life.
- Pray for times of rest and refreshment for all who are away this week. Remember also those who feel they cannot afford to go away, or those who are limited as they care for a loved one who needs constant care.
- Give thanks for Bishop Rachel as she returns from her mini sabbatical during which she visited Palestinians in the West Bank 'where there has been underreporting of the devastating situation; whilst the spotlight shines on the horrific situation in Gaza'. (see her reports on the Gloucester Diocesan website). Pray for all who are seeking to restore peace in the Middle East, and avoid escalation of the conflict.
- Give thanks for the SAT-7 broadcasts to the Middle East and North Africa, and pray that their programmes and viewer support teams will help new believers to grow in their faith, bringing glory to God.
- Pray for those who mourn the loss of Elaine Wood, funeral on 29th July in church.
