Prayer Pointers

(please take this bulletin home with you to pray)

- Pray for justice, peace and reconciliation in the Middle East; for people who are persecuted because of their faith in Jesus to find a strength and confidence in God that is unmatched and unrivalled. Ask God to change the hearts and minds of the people who are against Christians, and for new believers to be encouraged as they meet more Christians in their communities.
- As we mourn over world climate extremes and conflicts, pray that the Prince of Peace might teach us to stand in solidarity with the woundedness of others, of creation, and of the world; to make us **people of hope** with a vision of swords turned into ploughshares and tears transformed into joy.
- ⊕ For children and young people now that they have started in new classes at school or college after the summer break. Pray especially for young people who are leaving home for the first time to start University courses.
- ⊕ Continue to pray for **Project Inspire**, for God's provision and for guidance for the PCC and the project team as they decide the way ahead.
- Pray for the ministry of Scripture Union in Pakistan, where monsoon rains have caused severe flooding in the province of Punjab and in Karachi, threatening the livelihoods of poor families and likely damage to homes and school buildings. Please pray for safety for all affected and that property damage will be limited.

1st Monday (usually!) each month: we meet for our monthly Parish Prayer time, currently at the Vicarage.

Wednesdays 9am: we meet in the cottage to pray for half an hour – for our church, town and world.
