Prayer Pointers

- Pray that the ceasefire in the Middle East will continue. Now pray for all involved in planning the future management and governance of Gaza and the West Bank – that Palestinians themselves may be fully involved in decisions made.
- Pray for Christians in Parliament an All-Party Parliamentary Group which supports all Members and staff in their work in the Houses of Parliament. See https://www.christiansinparliament.org.uk/
- Give thanks for all the volunteers who give so much to our local community, both within the church fellowship and in the wider town activities. Pray for God's guidance as we all face the challenge of balancing our personal and family lives with our community service.
- Pray for all who attended the Men's or Ladies' Breakfasts yesterday as we reflect on the way God is working in different contexts, and for us all as we face the challenge of what God is calling us to do and be.
- Give thanks that Ram Prasad (working with ethnic minorities in Rochdale) with his wife Keshari is able to visit Lechlade this weekend. Pray for them both as they return to Rochdale and continue their ministry there.

Contribute to wildlife conservation. Clean bird feeders to prevent diseases spreading to winter migrants. Install a nest box well before breeding season to provide a cosy retreat for small birds during cold winter nights.
