## **Prayer Pointers**

(please take this bulletin home with you to pray)

- Today is the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church around the world. We especially pray for Pastors under Pressure who often face daily discrimination, threats of violence, and arrest. Pray for God to sustain their faith and protect their churches.
- As we approach the next International Climate Conference, COP30 (in Brazil, 10—21 Nov), pray for behaviour changes globally at every level, from individuals to communities to major world leaders, that will improve the situation and start to repair the damage caused by the climate crisis; pray for justice for people living in poverty, often those hit first by the devastating impacts of climate crisis, even though they usually contribute the least to cause the problem.
- Pray for those known to us who are unwell, at home, in hospital, or in a care home. Pray for those who care for them. Pray especially for our Vicar, Andrew, and his family, and for our Churchwardens (Paul and Susan) as they plan cover during Andrew's sickness.
- Pray for Canon Andy Roberts as he is formally commissioned as the new CEO of CMS (Church Mission Society) on Saturday 8th November. Give thanks for the work of CMS since 1799 - a long line of Jesus-followers who long for people at the edges to encounter Jesus, to discover the new life he brings and to share it with others around the world.



Taste the difference! Local and seasonal food tastes great and is better for the planet, so incorporate locally grown produce into your diet and shopping list throughout the seasons. If you say grace before a meal, give thanks for your local food producers this month.
