Prayer Pointers (please take this bulletin home)

- This **Advent**, as our minds turn to Christmas, may we not be overwhelmed by the busyness and commercialisation of Christmas activities, but take time to reflect on where we are in our lives before God.
- Pray for the many **Advent and Christmas programmes** in the next few weeks, especially in our local community, that these may all point people to a fresh understanding of Christ's love for us in a hurting world. Pray especially for the **Christingle** next Sunday afternoon, for all the families who come.
- ⊕ For the distribution of our Church Christmas cards that these may help our community to focus on the coming of Jesus as they celebrate.
- Continue to pray for those known to us who are unwell, at home, in hospital, or in a care: and those who care for them. Pray for our Vicar Andrew and his family as he gradually returns to ministry: also for the families of those who have died recently as they grieve.
- ♣ SAT-7 ask us to pray for Endurance and boldness for Christians in Iran and the Persian region who are facing heightened persecution and surveillance. May the Lord protect those who have been detained, comfort their families, and strengthen house fellowships that meet in secrecy. Pray for wisdom for believers as they navigate digital monitoring and government pressure.
