Prayer Pointers

- Lord, we remember how you were born homeless and laid in a manger. Fill us with compassion for all in need today. Help us to respond to your most generous gift of Jesus Christ, with loving service to others.
- As we long for peace around the world, let us pray for wisdom and strength for peacemakers and reconcilers; for local churches and leaders to resolve conflicts peacefully, knowing that peace is not merely the absence of violence, rather it is the presence of restored relationships, rebuilt trust, renewed hope.
- Pray that God may enrich and bless relationships between spouses, parents, children and siblings as families gather to celebrate Christmas and spend time together. Pray for families that are experiencing friction to find ways to live in greater harmony and understanding of each other. Pray especially for those who find Christmas a difficult time for whatever reason.
- Give thanks for the gift of music and the skills of those who lead our worship. Give thanks especially for the choir so ably led by Rachel. And for all who play the piano or organ and sing in the music group.
- Pray for the Diocese of Dornakal (South India) this Christmas, and especially for the plans to build a new English Medium School in Kothagudem.
