 - for a real sense of unity in the St Lawrence church family.
- ✚ Pray for global, national and local initiatives seeking to fulfil the UN Sustainable Development Goal 4 “**Quality Education**” – that all may have access to lifelong learning. Pray for children and young people attending local schools; for the teachers and all staff; for children and grandchildren we know as they continue in education.
- ✚ Pray for **Bishop Sarah Mullally as she officially takes up the position of Archbishop of Canterbury** on Thursday. May she be guided and strengthened and by God's grace be able to give a lead with wisdom, courage and compassion in this troubled world.
- ✚ As the world remembers **Holocaust Memorial Day** on Tuesday, we pray for all who are continuing to suffer injustice, discrimination and hatred.
- ✚ Pray for the **Diocese of Dornakal** (South India), and especially for the plans to build a new English Medium School in Kothagudem.
