- ✚ As we begin a new year, let us pray for progress towards the UN 17 Sustainable Development Goals. This week pray for global, national and local initiatives seeking to fulfil the Goal 1 "No Poverty" – ending extreme poverty worldwide.
- ✚ It can sometimes feel like there is no end in sight to the mounting list of conflicts in our world. Yet we serve the Prince of Peace who inspires us to believe a better, more peaceful world is possible.
